

IF IT'S FREE (OR LOW FEE), IT'S FOR ME!

That saying has become a mantra lately for travelers everywhere. So we've put together a list of our most popular free attractions and events in Lehigh Valley to help make your trip even easier on the budget. Visit www.DiscoverLehighValley.com for additional options.

1. Museums & Galleries

- [Liberty Bell Shrine Museum](#), Allentown – See a replica of the original Bell which was hidden from the British in this church. Donations appreciated.
- [Allentown Art Museum](#) – Admission to the facility's main galleries is free on Sundays only. A \$5 fee is charged for admission to the special exhibit area.
- [Banana Factory](#), Bethlehem – Watch a glass blowing demonstration, tour the galleries and 23 artists' studios and visit the gift shop selling handmade crafts.

2. Wineries - [Lehigh Valley Wine Trail](#) – Visit all nine of the family-owned and operated wineries in the region. Some wineries may charge a nominal fee for tastings.

3. Factory tour - [C.F. Martin Guitar Company](#), Nazareth – The one-hour tours are offered weekly from 11 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. After the tour, check out the 1833 gift shop, Pickin' Parlor and company museum. A small fee is charged for groups of 10 or more.

4. The Outdoors

- Go for a walk in Trexler Park, Lehigh Parkway or Cedar Beach Park, all located in Allentown; take a hike in Jacobsburg State Park, or discover nature during a walk along the Monocacy Creek in Bethlehem from Illick's Mill Road to Sand Island.
- Request a free **Lehigh Valley Cycling Maps** brochure for places to ride your bike.
- Fish along the Delaware and Lehigh Rivers as well as at numerous creeks and streams that traverse the region.

5. Trails and Tours

- Request a **Two Rivers Area Birding and Natural History Trail** brochure for places in Northampton County to discover the region's birds, flora and fauna.
- Request a free **Lehigh County Log Cabin Trail** brochure to discover its 22 historic log cabins.
- Take a driving tour to visit the **Covered Bridges of Lehigh Valley** when you request a free brochure with driving directions that takes you past all seven of them.

6. Music

- Bach at Noon concerts by [The Bach Choir of Bethlehem](#) – The second Tuesday of each month in spring and fall at Central Moravian Church in downtown Bethlehem. Doors open at 11:30 a.m.
- [Tunes at Twilight](#) – Held in Bethlehem's Sun Inn Courtyard on Thursday evenings in May and June from 6 - 8 p.m.
- [Allentown Band](#) at Allentown's West Park – Bring a folding chair or blanket and listen to a free concert in this picturesque park.

7. Festivals

- [Musikfest](#) each August and [Celtic Classic](#) each September, both in downtown Bethlehem
- [Heritage Day](#) each July and [Garlic Fest](#) each October, both in downtown Easton

8. Miscellaneous

- [First Friday](#) on Bethlehem's Southside, along 3rd and 4th Streets. A monthly celebration of arts and culture with shops, galleries, live music, in-store specials and refreshments.
