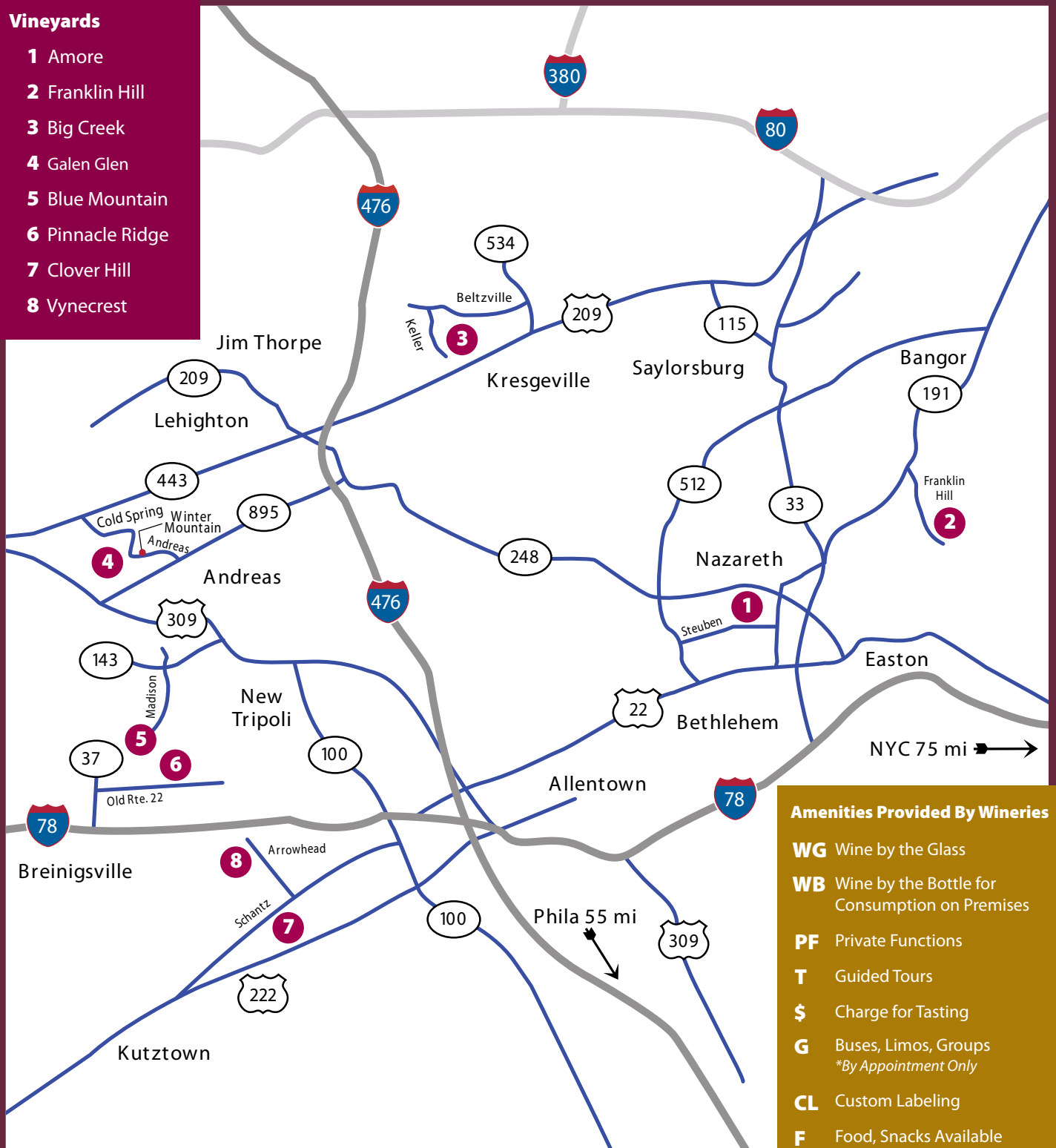

Wine in Bloom

3rd weekend of May

This event takes place mid-spring as bud break occurs on the vines. It celebrates the importance that terroir (soil) plays in the development of the grapes, their flavor and the resulting taste of the wine, and stresses the importance of the A.V.A. designation (American Viticultural Area) in further legitimizing the Lehigh Valley for wine making.

An A.V.A. designation was awarded in April 2008 to the Lehigh Valley region after a five-year application process. Wineries in the region are permitted to list "Lehigh Valley" as the growing region on their labels as long as a minimum of 75% of the grapes used in their wines are grown within the A.V.A.
