MUSEUM OF INDIAN CULTURE

Guests spending the night in the upstairs lounge have been awakened at 3 a.m. by the sound of loud footsteps, made by someone wearing heavy boots, walking down the hall and stopping at the lounge doorway.

Occasionally, a young girl has been seen carrying flowers. Some people have heard a bouncing ball and smelled the aroma of fresh flowers. Museum visitors have heard knocking in the library, seen doors swinging back and forth and have heard random loud thumps. People also have said that they experienced the feeling of being constantly watched.

Native Americans who spend the night are often awakened in the early-morning hours to a “wolf howling.” Flint-knapping sounds can be heard in the basement. Many have returned to the building after locking up the night before to find the front-door security bar on the floor.
